Adoption Events

Handle adoptable animals at the Beaufort and Bluffton Petsmart stores twice a month. Off Site Adoption Events other than Adoption Center and handle showcase adoptable animals at these events.

Must attend dog handler training if assignment is handling PAL dogs.

Cat Socialization

Spending quality time cuddling, petting, playing and interacting with cats at the adoption center.

Dog Walker

Spending quality time walking & training the adoptable dogs. Learning leadership skills.

Events

Help with PAL events (Adoption Events, Pets on the Promenade, parades, community events such as Beerfest, Bluffton Art & Seafood Festival, vaccine clinics, and birthday party celebrations. Help with PAL fund raising events such as food drives, Online Auction, etc.

Must attend dog handler training if assignment is handling PAL dogs.

Foster Cats or Dogs

Foster pets in your home temporarily until they can be adopted to a forever home or moved to the Adoption Center.

Must attend Foster Care Training session.

Thrift Store

Accept donations from public, process donations, price items and put on sales floor, keep store neat and clean, assist customers. Ability to run cash register a plus but not required.
